



Consultant Safety Protocol

The Start Well program and the Early Childhood Mental Health consultants are committed to the health and safety of the providers, children and parents of the early care and education community. Based on guidelines from the Center for Disease Control, Community Care Licensing, and the CA Office of Education, the consultants will take the following precautions:

1. Follow the safety procedures that are put in place by the ECE program.
2. Wear face covering over mouth and nose at all times.
3. Wash hands before entering a classroom.
4. Use hand sanitizer between meetings.
5. Take their temperature at the beginning of each day (self-screening).
6. Use alcohol wipes to sanitize laptops, phones and writing utensil between meetings.
7. Utilize their own writing utensils.
8. Monitor their symptoms of shortness of breath and/or cough throughout the day. Immediately leave the premises should symptoms develop.

Should there be an exposure to COVID-19:

- The ECMH consultant will quarantine at home for at least 14 days.
- The ECMH consultant will get tested within 48 hours.
- Please notify us as soon as possible of any COVID-19 exposure at your site.
